NO VEHICLES ARE PERMITTED IN THE PADDOCK AREA. All motorcycles & equipment must be walked into Paddock area. Please follow signs to competitors parking area.

1. WRIST BANDS.

- 1.1 Access to the Pits/Paddock Area is permitted to Officials, Competitors & Mechanics showing their securely attached wrist band.
- 1.2 Wrist Bands will be issued at sign on. Upon arriving at the circuit (before unloading your vehicle) **ALL OFFICIALS, COMPETITORS & MECHANICS MUST go to the SIGN ON SHED, sign on & receive their wrist band before attempting to gain access to Pits/Paddock Area.**

2. TIMING TRANSPONDERS.

- 2.1 Transponders can be collected from the table within the paddock area.
- 2.2 You will be required to leave your MA Licence / Junior Yellow Book as a deposit for your transponder. Your Licence will be returned to you when you return the transponder. Transponders can be returned when you have finished riding for the weekend.
- 2.3 If the transponder is damaged during the meeting or if it is not returned at the conclusion of the meeting you will receive an account for the replacement cost of the transponder.
- 2.4 Transponders must be securely attached to your motorcycle using the bracket provided, cable ties & tape before you present your motorcycle for Scrutineering
- 2.5 Juniors must present yellow folder containing log book at sign on & Transponder collection.
- 2.6 Timing Sheets will be posted on a board in front of the canteen.

3. SCRUTINEERING:

- 3.1 All motorcycles, equipment & protective clothing must be scrutineered before practice & comply with Current GCRs.
- 3.2 Attach your Transponder to your motorcycle before scrutineering.
- 3.3 Back protectors must be worn as per GCRs 20.1.1.2.4 or 5.

4. PRACTICE SESSIONS & CHANGES TO CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

- 4.1 Each competitor will get 1 practice Session per motorcycle entered. Your practice session will be your primary engine capacity class.
- 4.2 All Practice Sessions will be 3.5 Laps.
- 4.3 Junior 65cc & 85cc will be held over 5 heats.
- 4.4 Junior 125cc will have 2 heats per Round & will be held over 3 rounds with a Reperchage & Final.
- 4.5 The BATTLE of TWINS Class will be combined with OPEN Class, run & scored as one Class.
- 4.6 The Sidecar 600cc Class will be combined with Sidecar 1100cc Class, run & scored as one Class.

5. RIDING NUMBERS:

- 5.1 Your riding Number is on the attached form.
- 5.2 All numbers must be easily readable at 20 metres.

6. GATE ENTRY FEES:

- 6.1 Enclosed are your gate admission tickets, each ticket is valid for both Saturday & Sunday.
- 6.2 You've received 2 entry passes if Solo rider or 3 if Sidecar.
- 6.3 Additional passes can be purchased before the event for \$10ea (Limit 10 per competitor) by using the attached fax back form.
- 6.4 Anyone over 16yrs without an entry pass will be charged \$15 at the gate.

7. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

- 7.1 Fuel is NOT available at Nepean Raceway.
- 7.2 Environmental Protection mats must be used as per GCRs 20.5.0.3.
- 7.3 No person may wear open footwear in the paddock or pit area.
- 7.4 Only Juniors under 16 years of age who have entered the meeting may enter the Pit Area. No other person under 16yrs will be allowed in the Pit Area.

8. KNOBBY TYRES:

- 8.1 Knobby tyres are NOT permitted on the rear wheel of any motorcycle at Nepean.
- 8.2 with the exception of Juniors on motorcycles upto & including 85cc 2 strokes & 150cc 4 strokes.

9. CAMPING:

- 9.1 Camping is available at the track on Friday & Saturday night.
- 9.2 All noise, music etc must cease at 10.00pm
- 9.3 Any camp fires must be contained within a metal fire place eg cut down 44 gal. Drum etc. Any fire deemed unsafe by Nepean MSC Directors will be extinguished
- 9.4 The Canteen will be open on Saturday & Sunday between 7.30am to 4pm.
